### THE ST. MARK'S SCHOOL RECEIVES \$195,000 GRANT

It was with great joy that Father Bert recently learned that St. Mark's grant request to a local foundation was approved for \$195,000, the amount of our full request. The funds will go for organizational and start-up costs associated with the St. Mark's School, such as furniture, instructional materials and technology, a play-ground, and telephone and security systems. Our St. Mark's School will open in the Fall of 2014 with classes for two, three and four-year-old children and a "bridge" program to kindergarten. Applications for enrollment are now being accepted.
