## NEW BUILDING ALLOWS SACRISTY EXPANSION

With the construction of our Education Building, the nursery will be moved and the present nursery space will be converted to a new sacristy. A sacristy is a room in a church set apart for the preparation of the Holy Eucharist by the Altar Guild.

The St. Mark's Altar Guild, directed by Dorothy Dawlearn, is a group of hard-working church members dedicated to care of the altar and its furnishings and to preparation for Holy Eucharist. "We are all looking forward to the completion of the new building, and the Altar Guild especially is looking forward to moving into the new space," says Dorothy. "The new sacristy's proximity to the altar area will be a major convenience to the Altar Guild. In addition to being well-equipped for housekeeping, this new, more useful sacristy will provide ample storage spaces for all items used in the worship life of the parish, from vestments and hangings, sacred vessels and linens, candles, vases, as well the bread and wine used in the Eucharist. An Episcopal Church uses an incredible number of sacred items in its liturgy."

These consultants will help ensure now that we are building a preschool that will meet SAES's high standards of excellence when St. Mark's applies for accreditation after three years of operation.
