Godly Play Lesson – Sunday, April 19, 2020

There were many wonderful lessons Jesus taught us about the Kingdom of God. One of the ways Jesus taught us was in parables which are stories to help us understand how to be close to God. He said the Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed. It starts very small and over time grows into a tree. It shoots into large branches so that the birds of the air may nest under its shade. This story is told in Mark 4:26

Listen to the parable of the mustard seed found on the godly play website. How does the Kingdom of God grow like a mustard seed?

Activity: You will need an empty eggshell half, a little potting soil and a few flower or vegetable seeds. Have your child fill the eggshell with potting soil and plant the seeds. Place it in a sunny window and give it water each day. When the plant gets too large for the eggshell you can crack the shell slightly and transplant it outside into the ground or in a pot.
