Who is my neighbor? Love God by loving people as in The Parable of the Good Samaritan.

To prepare to teach the story of the Good Samaritan, read Luke 10:25-37 Access the video on godlyplay foundation.com The most engaging storyteller in my opinion is Amy Bradley. After watching the video the first time think of ways to engage your child. You might want to create some of the pieces used in telling the story. The dialog is also in pdf on the Godly Play website. Use fine art as a visual aid: there are many famous pieces of art that depict the Bible story of the Good Samaritan. One is by Rembrandt also known as The Charitable Samarian; another is the Good Samaritan by Vincent VanGogh. Art is not only beautiful but also serves as a teaching tool used to tell stories of the Bible at time when many people could not read.

Craft Activity: Help your child make a "Helping Hands" booklet. Draw an outline of your child's hand and duplicate it as many times as you like. Help your child name ways he or she can be a neighbor to others and write the ways on the cut out hands.
