Preparation for “The Good Shepherd”

Read Matthew 18:12-14 and Luke 15:1-7

Google a video of a shepherd calling his sheep. This is fascinating because the sheep really do recognize the shepherd’s voice!

See the ancient statue of Christ is the Good Shepherd in the Cleveland Museum of Art.

Art Project: Title is “Jesus is my Good Shepherd.” On a plain sheet of paper your child can color blue for a sky and green for grass. Cut out white circles or use cotton balls for the sheep’s bodies and black paper strips or pen for the legs and heads. The title can be written at the top or bottom.
