Summer Camp Fun

Come and join us for **SUMMET Camp Fun!** The program will meet the needs of children from the ages of 18 months - 3 years (Not potty trained); 3 years to 5 years (potty trained); and Kindergarten to rising 2nd grade students (students entering 3rd grade for the 2020-21 school year). **The camp program is from 9am-2pm. Before and After Care (BAC) is for enrolled campers Before from 6:30-9:00am & After camp from 2:00-6:00pm for an additional fee.** (Please fill out one form per child.)

The Summer Camp Fun program will be offered in one week sessions for ten weeks. Each week there will be a different fun theme, with activities and projects relating to the theme. All camps are offered Monday through Friday and include lunch time with lunch provided from home. The first week of camp is June 1-5 and the last week is August 10-14. The school is closed the week of July 1-5 and there will be no camp that week. No refunds for non-attendance during the week.

All weeks of camp, except the VBS week described below, are offered as Summer Camp Fun.

Vacation Bible School (VBS) week, date TBD, will feature "Joy to the World" theme.

- All campers will gather in the School to participate in before camp activities.
- At 9:30 children aged 3 and above will be escorted to morning VBS, as presented by St. Mark's Episcopal Church. Teachers for this age group will remain with the students during VBS. Lunch for children aged 3 and above will be at 12:35 daily during the VBS week.
- Children under 3 will remain with Staff assigned to the under 3 group in school. Younger campers will participate in Summer Camp Fun activities with lunch at 12:00.
- After lunch, the students will have rest time and fun activities throughout the afternoon.
- The school will pay the registration fee for VBS when students are attending camp.
- For this week, if you are interested in **only** VBS (9:30-12:30), please contact St. Mark's Episcopal Church at 281-545-1661 for the registration form and fee.

SMES Summer Camp Fun – 9:00AM - 2:00PM: The theme for each week of camp is as outlined below. You may choose two, three of five days per week. The Camp program includes:

- Theme Based Camp activities, craft projects, activity centers, exploration, recess and more.
- Lunch at 12:00 followed by rest time and theme based afternoon enrichment activities.

Before and After Care (BAC) – 6:30-9:00AM Before Care & 2:00-6:00PM After Care: The cost for the BAC is \$30 per week. The BAC program includes:

- Pre- and/or post- camp activities,
- Camp activities, as listed above,
- Afternoon snack provided from home and theme based afternoon enrichment activities.
- The cost for each week of BAC is \$30.00.

To enroll your child, please fill out the attached Camp Registration Form and return the form to the office with payment as outlined below:

- Signed up for less than 5 weeks of camp: Total Tuition and Fees due with registration form.
- Signed up for 5 or more weeks of camp: One-third of Total Tuition & Fees due with registration; One-third due by May 28 & Remaining balance due by June 22.

Please contact us if you need a payment plan.

All Campers Need:

- All campers require a ready to eat morning snack, and lunch, including a drink, provided from home each day.
- Children attending BAC-After Care also need a ready to eat afternoon snack.

- A cot will be assigned to each child for the summer. All children need a cot sheet (available at the front office for \$10.00) and a small blanket for rest time. Rest time materials must fit in a 2-gal Ziploc bag. Crib sheets and Nap Mats are not allowed. For safety concerns, pillows and stuffed animals are not allowed.
- We will be going outside every day, weather permitting. Sunscreen and bug spray, as appropriate for your child, should be applied at home each day. We will re-apply sunscreen and bug spray as provided by you, based on the signed permission slip included in your Camp registration packet. Please provide bug spray and sunscreen in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on the outside.
- Closed toe shoes are required for the playground. Sandals and flip-flops are not allowed.
- Children in diapers or pull-ups are required to provide all diaper and pull-up supplies from home, including baby wipes and diaper cream. Please label all supplies with child's name.
- All campers should provide a spare change of clothes, including socks, shoes, and underwear.
- Each camper should provide a box of tissues and a box of gallon Ziploc bags for school use.
- Each week will include activities that incorporate science, math, language, art and music. Fridays will be FUN DAYS! On this day camp activities will focus on Sports, Songs, Special Activities, Bubbles, and MORE! Teachers will let parents know if students need Water Shoes, and Towels for Friday.

If you are currently registered at St. Mark's School we will use the information on file. Please update any information as needed for summer.

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Descriptions of each Camp Week

Week One: June 1 - June 5: Silly Songs, Stories & Nursery Rhymes!: We're learning silly songs, reading silly stories and reciting favorite nursery rhymes.

Week Two: June 8 - June 12: Hooray for the Red, White & Blue: We will learn about the flag and other symbols of our country. Why are there stripes? How many stars are there?

Week Three: June 15 - June 19: Watch it Change! STEM Engineering: We will use our observation skills to watch things change as art and science collide in this fun filled week.

Week Four: June 22- June 26: VBS Joy to the World: (for 3 years and up) plus Our Amazing Ocean Friends: We will learn about the beautiful fish and fantastic creatures in our oceans and seas. We will read the book Rainbow Fish and learn about the joy of sharing. *VBS dates are TBD. If VBS is not this week, then the theme for the week VBS is scheduled will be switched to this week.

June 29 - July 3: No Camp - School is Closed

Week Five: July 6 - July 10: The Amazing World of Eric Carle: We will read a different Eric Carle book each day and learn about the amazing creatures in the stories.

Week Six: July 13 - July 17: Transportation - Planes, Trains, Trucks, Ships & Cars: Come explore the ways we travel. Does it have wings? Does it have wheels? Does it go on rails? Does it have a sail? Each day we will talk about a different way to travel by air, land or water.

Week Seven: July 20 - July 24: Fun with Dr. Seuss: We will explore the fascinating world of Dr. Seuss. We will read several favorite Dr. Seuss books and make up some adventures of our own.

Week Eight: July 27 - July 31: Games, Games and Olympics: This is the year of the summer Olympic Games to be held in Tokyo. We will have our own kid friendly exploration of games and sports.

Week Nine: August 3 - August 7: Around the World in Five Days: Get your passports ready. Each day we will travel to a different country. What do they eat? What language do they speak? Do they have special animals or clothes? We will go on a week long journey to answer these questions and many more.

Week Ten: August 10 - August 14: What's Growing in the Garden?: We will explore all things garden this week, flowers, vegetables, herbs and bugs!

August 17 - August 21: No Camp - Staff In-Service Week.
