Summer Camp Fun

Come and join us for **Summer Camp Fun!** The program will meet the needs of children from the ages of 18 months - 3 years (Not potty trained); 3 years to 5 years (potty trained); and Kindergarten to rising 3rd grade students (students entering 4th grade for the 2019-20 school year). **The camp program is from 9am-2pm. Before and After Care (BAC) is offered to enrolled campers from 6:30-9:00am Before & After from 2:00-6:00pm for an additional fee.** (Please fill out one form per child.)

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The Summer Camp Fun program will be offered in one week sessions for eleven weeks. Each week there will be a different fun theme, with activities and projects relating to the theme. All camps are offered Monday through Friday and include lunch time with lunch provided from home. The first week of camp is June 3-7 and the last week is August 19-23. The school is closed the week of July 1-5 and there will be no camp that week. No refunds for non-attendance during the week.

All weeks of camp, except the VBS week described below, are offered as Summer Camp Fun.

Vacation Bible School (VBS) week, date TBD, will feature "To Mars & Beyond" theme.

- All campers will gather in the School to participate in before camp activities.
- At 9:30 children aged 3 and above will be escorted to morning VBS, as presented by St. Mark's Episcopal Church. Teachers for this age group will remain with the students during VBS. Lunch for children aged 3 and above will be at 12:35 daily during the VBS week.
- Children under 3 will remain with Staff assigned to the under 3 group in school. Younger campers will participate in Summer Camp Fun activities with lunch at 12:00.
- After lunch, the students will have rest time and fun activities throughout the afternoon.
- The school will pay the registration fee for VBS when students are attending camp.
- For this week, if you are interested in **only** VBS (M-Th, 9:30-12:30), please contact St. Mark's Episcopal Church at 281-545-1661 for the registration form and fee.

SMES Summer Camp Fun – 9:00AM - 2:00PM: The theme for each week of camp is as outlined below. You may choose two, three of five days per week. The Camp program includes:

- Theme Based Camp activities, craft projects, activity centers, exploration, recess and more.
- Lunch at 12:00 followed by rest time and theme based afternoon enrichment activities.

Before and After Care (BAC) – 6:30-9:00AM Before Care & 2:00-6:00PM After Care: The cost for the BAC is \$30 per week. The BAC program includes:

- Pre- and/or post- camp activities,
- Camp activities, as listed above,

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- Afternoon snack provided from home and theme based afternoon enrichment activities.
- The cost for each week of BAC is \$30.00.

To enroll your child, please fill out the attached Camp Registration Form and return the form to the office by with payment as outlined below:

- Signed up for less than 5 weeks of camp: Total Tuition and Fees due with registration form.
- Signed up for 5 or more weeks of camp: One-third of Total Tuition & Fees due with registration; One-third due by May 30 & Remaining balance due by June 20.

All Campers Need:

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- All campers require a ready to eat morning snack, and lunch, including a drink, provided from home each day.
- Children attending BAC-After Care also need a ready to eat afternoon snack.
- A cot will be assigned to each child for the summer. All children need a cot sheet (available at the front office for \$10.00) and a small blanket for rest time. Rest time materials must fit in a 2-gal Ziploc bag. Crib sheets and Nap Mats are not allowed. For safety concerns, pillows and stuffed animals are not allowed.
- We will be going outside every day, weather permitting. Sunscreen and bug spray, as appropriate for your child, should be applied at home each day. We will re-apply sunscreen and bug spray as provided by you, based on the signed permission slip included in your Camp registration packet. Please provide bug spray and sunscreen in a Ziploc bag with your child's name on the outside.
- Closed toe shoes are required for the playground. Sandals and flip-flops are not allowed.
- Children in diapers or pull-ups are required to provide all diaper and pull-up supplies from home, including baby wipes and diaper cream. Please label all supplies with child's name.
- All campers should provide a spare change of clothes, including socks, shoes, and underwear.

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Camp:

- Each camper should provide a box of tissues and a box of gallon Ziploc bags for school use.
- Each week will include activities that incorporate science, math, language, art and music. **Fridays will be FUN DAYS!** On this day camp activities will focus on Sports, Splashes, Bubbles, Buckets, and MORE! Teachers will let parents know if students need, Swimsuits, Water Shoes, and Towels for Friday.

Descriptions of each Camp Week

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Week One: June 3 - June 7: **Shipwrecked!:** We're stranded on an island. Let's explore what is here. We need a place to stay. Maybe there's buried treasure. Is that a ship I see in the distance?

Week Two: June 10 - June 14: VBS To Mars & Beyond: (for 3 years and up) plus Let's Get Lost in Space: Travel the solar system learning about the planets, the milky way, comets and meteors! We may even visit the moon and collect a little moon dust to bring home.

Week Three: June 17 - June 21: **It's Not Just a Box! STEM Engineering**: We will use our engineering skills to create cities, bridges, vehicles, and more! We will be on a journey, only limited by our imagination.

Week Four: June 24 - June 28: **Stars and Stripes**: It's Yankee Doodle Dandy time! We will learn about the flag, Uncle Sam, Independence Day and show our love for the Red, White & Blue!

July 1 - July 5: No Camp - School is Closed

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Week Five: July 8 - July 12: Bears, Bears and More Bears: We will learn all about bears and enjoy a teddy bear picnic, too.

Week Six: July 15 - July 19: **Backyard Bug Out Bash**: Come explore the wonders of our backyard. Learn about plants and the incredible insects that are in our garden.

Week Seven: July 22 - July 26: Barnyard Fun: Learn about all the activities and animals on the farm. We will collect eggs from the chicken. We will milk the cow and churn butter. (No live animals this week!)

Week Eight: July 29 - August 2: **Zoo Animals Around the World:** Discover exotic animals from around the world. What is a marsupial? Hop along with kangaroos from Australia. Swing from the trees with monkeys. What does a giant Panda from China eat? And lots, lots more.

Week Nine: August 5 - August 9: **Once Upon a Time** . . . : Long ago and far away there were princesses and knights. There were fantastic stories about talking animals. Come enjoy our land of enchantment and go on an adventure of your own.

Week Ten: August 12 - August 16: Diggin' Dino Detectives: The dinosaurs are missing! Come hunt for our prehistoric friends. Dig for bones and learn about dinosaurs.

Week Eleven: August 19 - August 23: Surf's Up! Sand & Water Fun: Let's have a lazy day at the beach. Play in the sand and water. Sit under the palm trees and listen to the waves roll in.
